

**SITE COUNCIL MINUTES
OCTOBER 14, 2009**

- 1). Board meeting called to order by Terri Spriet, President, at 3:22 pm. Those present Included: Lori Hale, Michelle Monkman, Carol Adlrich, Brenda Giesen, and Mardel Bose.
- 2). Michelle made a motion to approve minutes for September and Lori seconded. Motion passed.
- 3). Carol Adlrich reported on the West Hills reading groups. Back to back DIBELS testing is in full swing. Title I is delighted to have the new Promethean Board. Only three are without boards . The cost of these boards are \$1,300.00 plus \$174.00 for two sets of new brackets. Clickers are separate to purchase. Carol reported clickers are an additional expense. Lincoln has one set and one activslate. Lincoln was wands for all their boards.
- 4). Lincoln Title I Report. Lincoln met to review students progress and continues to Progress monitor. They have started a 2nd intervention for some students. Numbers in the initial DIBELS:
 1st grade---13% intensive, 30% strategic, 57% benchmark
 2nd grade---36% intensive, 12% strategic, 53% benchmark
 Progress monitoring is happening every couple weeks and both schools are looking to set up a Title I Parent Night.
- 5). School Improvement Plan: Everyone given a copy of the SMART goal setting worksheet.
- 6). Discussion followed. We need to review what we have and take a look at goals and progress. If something still needs to remain a goal then reset. If a goal has been met then look for something else to work on. It is not mandatory to throw them out and start over. At West Hills it is tied to writing assessment, PLC goals and math and Language arts goal. At Lincoln PLC and writing. Lori Hale said writing is a focus for most schools in the district. Step Up To Writing was in place last year in grades 1-5 and Kid Writing in Kindergarten.
- 7). PLC is meeting weekly at Lincoln to focus on writing. Lori is excited about PLC's. They are working at how to mesh goals between grades. The goal at West Hills is on 3rd grade writing. Literacy coach is working with teachers and offering support.
- 8). Book Fair at West Hills is set up.
- 9). Both schools are ready for conferences.
- 10). West Hills begins OAKS testing Thursday. They hope to have first round finished by Conferences.
- 11). Lincoln is taking flu precautions. Lincoln had 30 students out on Monday. West Hills had 40.
